Activity:

Interaction tables provide a systematic, top-down description of the key functions available to users, the objects in the system, and the details of how users interact with them. The goal is to ensure completeness and coherence across the system.

Start by listing all the conceptual objects in the system, then list the functions available for ma-

nipulating them. For example, conceptual objects might include maps and routes, and the functions might include creating or modifying them. Next, describe how each object is represented in the interface, how to access each function via an interaction technique, and which interaction techniques affect which functions.
